How to Make a Ballet Bun

- 1. Purchase supplies. You will need a good elastic band, bobby or hairpins, hairnet matching the dancer's hair color, and hairspray or hair gel for hard to control hair.
- 2. Use a brush to form hair into a neat ponytail. The placement of the ponytail will determine the placement of the bun; high, medium, low, or double buns. Use the elastic band to secure the ponytail
- 3. Twist the ponytail and then begin to coil the ponytail around the hair elastic.
- 4. Use hairpins to fasten the bun, pushing them from the outside in, in the fashion of a compass, N, S, E, W, NE, NW, SE, SW etc. until the bun feels firmly secured. It is key to connect the bun to the hair leading into the ponytail.
- 5. Wrap a fine hair net around the bun and place a few extra pins to secure.
- 6. Finish with a light coating of hair spray and smooth any wisps.
